Creative Learning In The Classroom uniquely demonstrates hands-on story creation and video production in two 5th grade classrooms. Through documentary footage, interviews with students, classroom teachers, and teaching artists in film and theatre, the program offers both instruction and inspiration for integrating digital media into the curriculum. Creative Learning in the Classroom is designed to give educators an inside look into arts and media learning that results in successful student collaboration and original films.

Creative Learning In The Classroom features an instructional film and special features that inspire and instruct teachers to integrate digital media and story-making into their classrooms.

The program follows the process as two classes create original stories and turn them into education media. It includes interviews with students and educators along with extra features that share the details for story creation and filmmaking.

The guidebook is the teacher's own filmmaking diary that includes the curriculum, handouts, and exercises as well as plenty of room for notes. A CD containing a digital version of the handbook is also included.
